

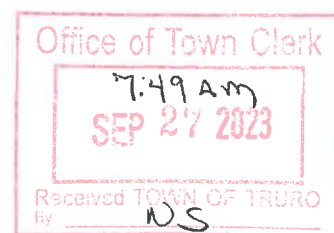
Truro Concert Committee meeting approved minutes, June 7, 2023

Last minutes (May)

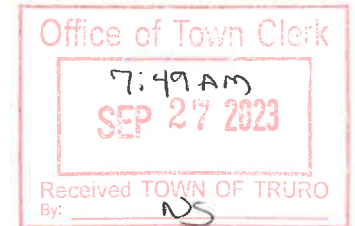
- Approved

Teeshirts

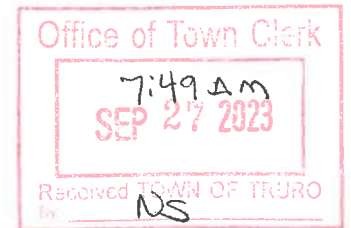
- We'll not print teeshirts this year.

- Seaman's Bank \$13K is not a grant; it's part of the regular donations. Ken and Tim will say thanks personally.

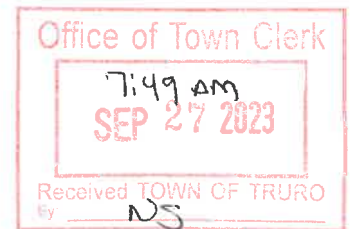
Rack cards
